

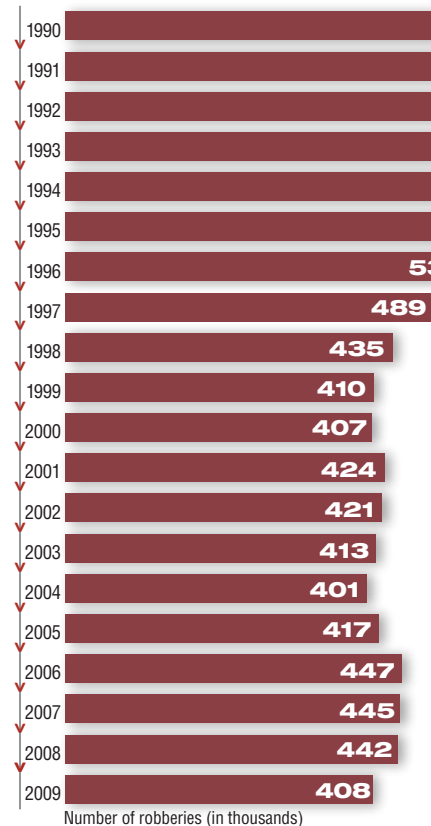

Robberies in the United States

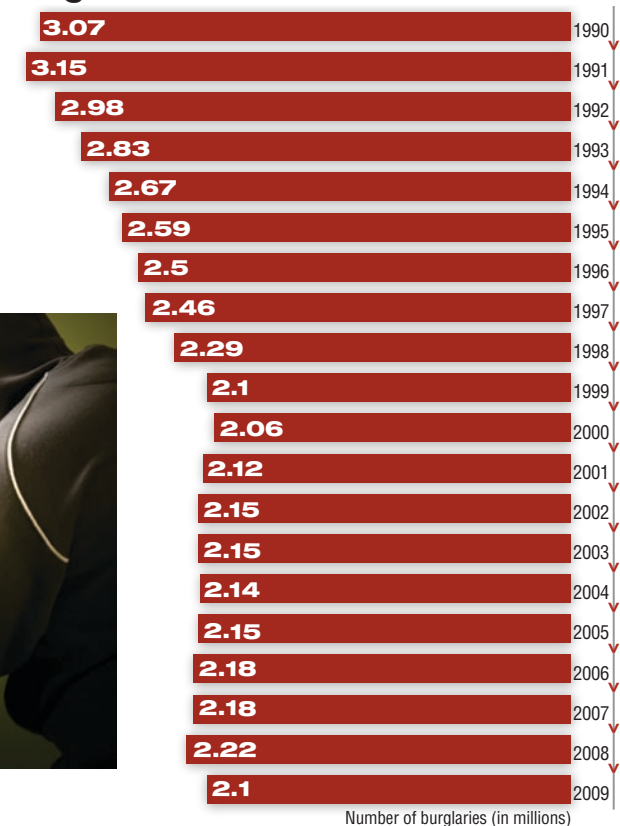


Number of robberies (in thousands)

The estimated number of robberies in 2009 decreased 8.8 percent from the 2008 data. An estimated \$508 million in losses were attributed to robberies in 2009, with the average dollar loss per robbery offense coming in at \$1,244.

Burglaries in the United States



Number of burglaries (in millions)

The estimated number of burglaries decreased 1.3 percent when compared with 2008 data. Of all burglaries, 61 percent involved forcible entry, 32.6 percent were unlawful entries (without force), and the remainder (6.5 percent) were forcible entry attempts.
